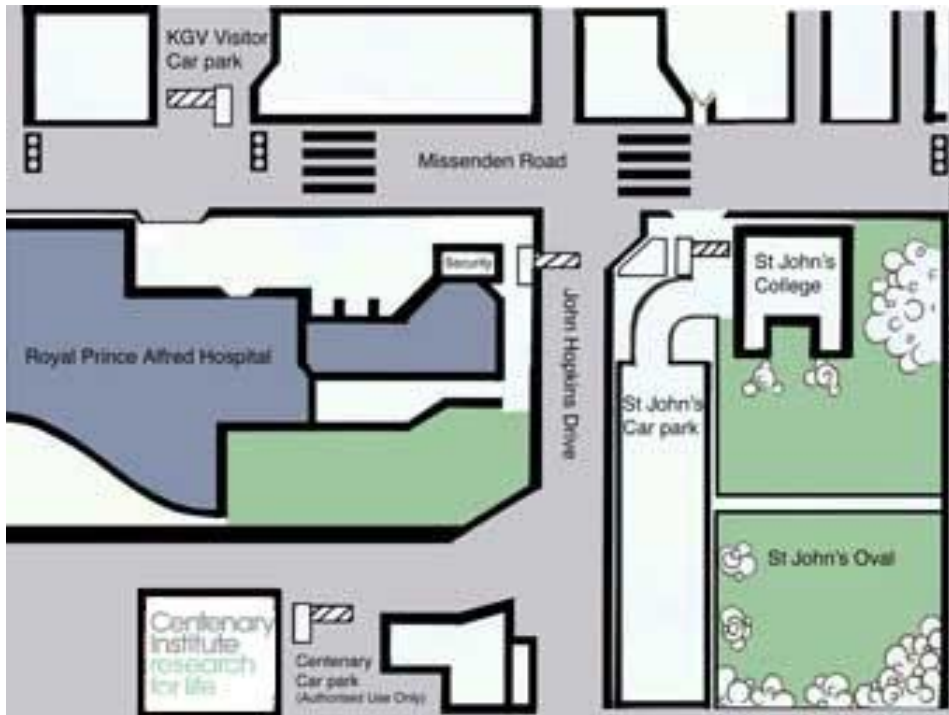

How to get to the Centenary Institute

Bus services from the City

Bus route 412 stops on Missenden road in front of the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital.

Bus routes 435, 436, 437, 438, 440, 461 and 480 stop at the intersection of Parramatta Road and Missenden Road (BP service station). A 3 minute walk along Missenden Road takes you to John Hopkins Drive (on your left hand side). Follow the road down to the Centenary Institute.

Bus routes 422, 423, 426 and 428 stop at the intersection of King Street and Missenden Road. A 5 minute walk along Missenden Road takes you to John Hopkins Drive (on your right hand side). Follow the road down to the Centenary Institute.

Parking

Visitors driving to Centenary Institute can choose to park in either:

St John's car park
 Enter from Missenden Rd
 After 3.30pm – Flat rate \$7

or

KGV car park
 Turn from Missenden Rd
 Cost - \$5 per day (exact coins required)
